
WELCOME AND THANK YOU


Hi there! Hello to all returning families and those new to Oswald Road.

Firstly, many thanks for all your generosity and support during the past academic year; we raised £15,000 from our fundraising efforts, which has gone towards our ongoing playground initiatives, including the wonderful treehouse! We have also been successful with some grants. Thank you for your help with both the Tesco campaign, which awarded us a fantastic £2,000 towards the Owl Garden changes, and the Aviva Community Fund, which granted us £1,000 towards the running track, which will be installed during October half term.

We also received £800 from the Tree Council towards tree planting and a £800 clean up grant from TK Maxx, which we will use mainly towards perimeter planting to help clean up the air our children breathe in the playground. Please e-mail if you are greenfingered as we need guidance re which plants to choose and planting them. We will be planting during National Tree Week from 25th Nov to 1st Dec. Please do come and join us after the school fair on 30th November to help with the planting. Many hands make light work.



FRIDAY COFFEE MORNINGS


Every Friday 9-10am in the Small hall. All welcome


