Maths: This week we will be working on place value to 20

Useful vocabulary: count, more, less, tens, ones, teen, greater, smaller

How you can support at home:

Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20, starting from any number.

Look at how to spell the words for numbers to 20.

English:

This week we will be looking at The Jolly Postman

How you can support at home:

Have a look at any letters or postcards you have at home and talk about their features.

Phonics:

We will continue to look at and consolidate Phase 4. No new sounds are taught but we learn about reading and spelling words with common consonant clusters that come at the beginning of words. E.g st in stop, sl in slow, tw in twin/

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for Phase 4 sounds in any books you are reading at home.
