Maths

We are continuing our unit on money.

We will compare amounts of money using the inequality signs (<, > and =). The children will also expand their knowledge of addition and subtraction strategies by finding the difference between two given amounts e.g. Mr Farrow has £2 and 15 pence; Mrs Hickman has £2 and 40 pence. How much more does Mrs Hickman have?

English

We will be continuing our journey into 'The Dark' by Lemony Snickett. The children have been doing some fabulous writing about the dark so far, using some excellent verbs and adverbs!

Spellings

This week's spellings are the common exception words:

improve, sure, sugar, eye, could, would, should, who, whole, any, parents, Christmas.
