Maths: This week we will be working on recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

Useful vocabulary: sides, corners, vertices, edges, faces, corners, cuboid, cube, pyramid, cylinder, cone, sphere, rectangle, circle, square, triangle

How you can support at home:

Go on a shape hunt around your house—how many different shapes can you find?

English: This week we will start a new unit on Traditional Tales. We will be looking at fairy tales and how they are structured.

How you can support at home:

Think about any traditional tales you already know- can your child retell it?

Phonics: We will continue to look at and consolidate Phase 4.

No new sounds are taught, but we learn about reading and spelling words with common consonant clusters that come at the beginning of words. We will be looking at some Phase 4 polysyllabic words (words with more than one syllable).

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for Phase 4 sounds and polysyllabic words in any books you are reading at home.
