Maths: Next week we will continuing our work on shape, consolidating the tricky vocabulary.

Useful vocabulary: sides, corners, vertices, edges, faces, corners, cuboid, cube, pyramid, cylinder, cone, sphere, rectangle, circle, square, triangle

How you can support at home:

Go on a shape hunt around your house—how many different shapes can you find? Can you describe it's properties?

English: We will be continuing our work on traditional tales, focusing on alternative endings within fairy tales, leading up to writing our own alternative ending to a story!

How you can support at home:

Look at the endings of any stories you are reading at home, what are the similarities and differences between their endings?

Phonics: This week we will begin to look at Phase 5 sounds. This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will be focusing on ay, a-e (such as cake and bake) and ea.

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work.
