Maths: This week we will be consolidating our work on our addition. We will be recapping how to use a part-whole model to solve missing number problems.

Useful vocabulary: add, more, less, total, part, whole, altogether, equal, greater, smaller.

How you can support at home:

Bring addition into your daily routines eg. 'You have 6 teddies in your bed, and your sibling has 4, how many altogether?' Have a go at writing it as a number sentence.

English: We will be having a look at some non-fiction writing, focusing on the key features of instructions.

How you can support at home:

Have a look at any instructions you have at home (eg. recipes, how to play a game, how to build furniture) and look at how they are set out and the type of language they use.

Phomics: This week we will continue to look at Phase 5 sounds. This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will recap the split digraph a_e and have a look at different ways of making the 'ee' sound, ea and split digraph e_e.

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for any of these sounds in books you are reading at home.
