How you can support at home:

English: We will be finishing our work on instructions by making a Christmas craft and writing our own instructions.

How you can support at home:

Any writing about Christmas or winter! Children may want to discuss some different things you see at Christmas such as Santa, snowmen, Christmas trees and write some sentences.

Phonics: This week we will continue to look at Phase 5 sounds.

This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will recap the digraphs we have done so far and learn about the 'ie' sound.

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for any of these sounds in books you are reading at home.
