The Hoot

Maths: This week we will be working on addition to 20. We will be looking at how to use a number line to solve addition problems, and finding number bonds to 20.

Useful vocabulary: addition, more, bigger, total, count on, how many, number bonds, part, whole.

How you can support at home:

Use everyday objects to practise addition within 20.

Eg, You have 12 raisins, here are 5 more. How many do you have altogether?

English: This week we will be exploring the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

How you can support at home:

Practise retelling stories at home! Can you sequence the events in the correct order?

Phonics: This week we will continue to look at Phase 5 sounds.

This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will recap the digraphs we have done so far and learn about the i_e split digraph and the 'y' sound (as in 'spy' and 'fly')

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for any of these sounds in books you are reading at home.
