### **MATHS:**

We'll be learning all about Roman Numerals and using these to do simple calculations and to tell the time. We'll be solving Roman word problems and applying our mathematical skills to calculate the distances travelled on foot by Roman soldiers.



We will be discussing which rights were not being respected during the Roman times. What did it mean to be a Roman citizen? A Roman slave? What makes us a British citizen? Should citizens all have the same rights and how do we establish equality for all?

# What have the Romans ever done for us? Part II

### **SCIENCE:**

Our science topic this half term is 'animals including humans'. We will be investigating what humans and animals need to survive—focusing closely on diet.

**MUSIC:** We'll be listening to music from Ancient Rome and learning about the kinds of instruments they used. We'll continue to sing in unison and harmony and to play untuned percussion to create our own compositions.

**GEOGRAPHY:** We'll be learning about the architecture in the Ancient city of Rome and how the Romans designed their settlements around a grid based system.

We will also be identifying Roman roads still used today!

#### **HISTORY:**

This term we will be focusing on Roman life—from bath houses to gladiator rings. We will also look closely at ingenious Roman inventions - such as aqueducts, sewers and the modern calendar!



## **DT/ART:**

This term, we will be getting ready for battle by designing and making our own Scutum and Gladius.
