From Monday 20th January we will be running an afterschool 'Lego WeDo' club for Years 4 and 5, for five weeks up until half term. The sessions will last for one hour each, finishing at 4.30pm.

Through project-based activities, pupils' skills are enhanced across science, coding, engineering and technology. The unique combination of the Lego brick, classroom-friendly software and inspiring, curriculum-relevant science projects results in a resource that builds pupils' confidence, empowers them to ask the right questions, define problems, and design their own solutions by putting scientific discovery in their hands.
