Tuesday 28th January—Year 1 Trip to The Lowry Maths: This week we will continue with addition to 20. First we will be using number bonds to 10 and using these to help us to make number bonds to 20.

*Useful vocabulary:* addition, more, bigger, total, count on, how many, number bonds, part, whole, partition.

### How you can support at home:

Use everyday objects to practise addition within 20.

You have 14 grapes, how many more do you need so you have 20 grapes?

**English:** This week we will be continuing with work on Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be writing the story of Jack and the Beanstalk in three parts- the beginning, the middle and the end.

How you can support at home:

Practise retelling stories at home!

**Phonics:** This week we will continue to look at Phase 5 sounds.

This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will recap the diagraphs we have done so far and also continue to practise the alternative long 'i' vowel diagraphs eg. igh as in night, ie as in pie, i-e as in kite, i as in find and y as in sky.

#### How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work. Keep an eye out for any of these sounds in books you are reading at home.
