The Hoot

Mottos: This week we will be counting in 2's and 5's forwards and backwards. We will look carefully at what patterns we can see when counting in these numbers.

Useful vocabulary: twos, fives, pattern, odd, even, order.

How you can support at home:

Count forwards and backwards in 2's and 5's. Use objects such as socks in a pair and ask how many there are altogether by counting in 2's. Use 5p coins to support counting in 5's.

English: This week we will look initially at any holiday news the children would like to share with the class. We will then move on to our new book which links to our topic work, called 'Man on the Moon'. We will look at tricky words we might find in this story and talk about what they mean. We will explore the story together as a class.

How you can support at home:

Talk with your child about anything they have done in the holidays that they would like to share with the class.

Phonics: This week we will continue to look at Phase 5 sounds.

This is where children learn new ways of writing a sound. We will recap the diagraphs we have done so far and also continue to work and practise the following diagraphs <u>ir</u> as in 'bird', <u>ear</u> as in 'earth' and <u>or</u> as in 'world.'

Reading strategy of the week:

Read the rest of the sentence—If there is an unknown word then continue to the end of the sentence. This can then help to understand the word in context.
