#### Science Habitats

We will be blocking our science topic after the Easter holidays. We will look forward to learning about habitats and what animals need to survive in different environments. We will also be searching for minibeasts!

## <u>ICT</u>

In ICT we will be using our time to practice our spellings, times tables and maths skills. In class we will use the iPad apps to make talking cartoons and green screen films.

### Geography

In Geography we will be learning about a selection of African countries through our English stories. We will develop our understanding of location through atlas work and compare and contrast them with the UK.

#### Music

In Music we will be learning how to control and develop our singing voices as well as how to control instruments such as the Djembe.

## Maths

In maths we will be focusing on four main things this half term: fractions of shapes and quantities, measurements including the units ml/l, g/kg, cm/m, time - o'clock, half past, quarter to and past and position and direction. Following on from this we will be solving real-life word problems and using our knowledge of number facts and operations to check our results.

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#### Art

In art we will be learning about symbols in African art work and we will be using this to inspire us to create our own 'Secret Symbol'. We will also be designing and making our own kente cloth as well as a collage.

#### **Religious Education**

In RE we will be continuing our studies of Judaism through RE day.
