Pupil Premium Entitlement

As trips, clubs and extracurricular activities come back to school we would like to remind you of the activities you can access.

External clubs:

Clubs will be coming back after half term and you can access one club free of charge for 1 term.

Music:

You can access 1 instrument lesson free of charge.

Trips:

You can access all trips free of charge or make a subsidised contribution.

We also use the Pupil Premium grant in a number of other ways, whilst ensuring it is carefully targeted for those eligible children in order to help them achieve their potential both academically and socially.

The main ways we spend the money are:

- To part fund provision of smaller group teaching by both teachers and teaching assistants
- To support our funding of specialist art and music/performance teachers
- To fund the provision of specific resources to support and improve achievement
- To fund the provision of support for non-academic interventions to help increase self-esteem, develop social skills, improve relationships, confidence etc
- To subsidise extracurricular activities, visitors and performers to school

Pupil Premium Entitlement

Pupil Premium is additional funding that school can receive to support those students who are or have been entitled to Free School Meals in the last six years. Entitlement to Free School Meals is based on the Parent/Carer receiving any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit

To ensure your child is receiving their full entitlement we can check your Pupil Premium eligibility on your behalf, however we do ask that you give us permission by simply completing the following:
