

Expressive Art

This half term, we are going to be learning and joining in with lots of new nursery rhymes. We are going to explore our new environment and begin to use different resources to support our play.

We will explore different colours using paint and find out what happens when we mix colour together.

We will be working as a team to help each other tidy all the different areas in nursery. We are going to become confident learners and begin by asking 'grown ups' for help when we need it. We are really excited to make lots of new friends and talk to them about our family.

Physical Development

Now we have started Ozzy Owls Nursery, it is really important for us to work hard to become independent learners. We will be learning to communicate with adults about our needs, especially when we are hungry, thirsty or need to use the toilet. We will be using lots of one-handed tools for cutting, writing, sticking and painting.

Understanding of the World

Through our topic 'I am Special', we are going to talk about our families and what makes us unique. As the season changes and we move into Autumn we will be looking closely at changes and asking lots of questions.

Communication and Language

We will be using our listening ears to follow instructions and get to know our daily routine. We will be listening to each other in our keyworker groups as we talk about our thoughts and feelings.

During story time, we will begin to use sentences to talk about "who, what, when and how?"
