Objectives for spending PPG:

- To provide a higher level of pastoral care
- To provide personalised learning for all children
- To train teachers in further collaborative teaching / learning strategies
- To raise standards in reading, writing and maths.
- To provide further enrichment to the curriculum

Staffing Costs:

Teaching and Learning Responsibility Allowance (TLR) : focus on extended learning, CPD for staff on enrichment in the curriculum, monitoring opportunities, monitoring data, monitoring impact.

Learning Mentor: to work with children and their families.

Teaching Assistants: Interventions across school (in addition to intervention provided by SEN and EMA teams) to allow for targeted intervention to develop levels of learning and progress.

Interventions to include:

1:1 sessions Group sessions Raising Attainment Plans

Reading Recovery Teacher: Part funded by PPG to close the gaps in reading for designated children at an early age.

External Staff Training:

CPD for staff: to develop our staff's skills further to benefit children and to increase levels of accelerated progress. MOT 1 course for four teaching staff to be disseminated to whole teaching staff.

Enrichment Activities:

Trips: To subsidise trips for families on FSM.

Resources:

To ensure school has resources to appeal to all learning styles.
