

Reminders:

At Ozzy's Little Owls Nursery we have fun playing outside in all weathers. Please ensure that your child has the following items in a clearly labelled bag on their peg. It would be extremely helpful if all items were labelled with your child's full name.

- A waterproof coat (Waterproof trousers would also be great but not essential)
- A spare set of clothes
- Wellies
- Sun cream
- Sunhat

To avoid any upset or potential loss we highly recommend that you do not allow your child to bring in any of their own toys or comforters from home. We will have special days on which the children can share items from home if they would like – we will notify you of these dates across the year.
