

Science

Animals, including humans.

In Science, we will be learning about how animals and humans keep themselves healthy with the things that they eat, as well as exercise. How do you keep yourself healthy? Do you know what things you need to survive?

Geography

Wolves & Woodlands

We will be learning all about wolves and their habitat. We will be studying how wolves are unique animals and then we will write a report with all the facts that we have learned. We will also be learning about woodlands by using our map and compass skills.

Art

Have you noticed how leaves change with the seasons? We will be using our observation skills to create leaf collages and paintings.

Music

In Music, we will be learning how to control and develop our singing voices.

Maths

This half term, we will be exploring numbers. This will include recognising place value in numbers, knowing our number bonds to 10 and using this to find other number related facts. We will be halving and doubling numbers to at least 20, as well as reading and writing 2 and 3 digit numbers in figures and words. Finally, we will use knowledge of numbers to solve problems.

Literacy

We will be reading and writing information texts about wolves. We will be describing settings and characters for a story. We are going to write a story about real wolves, based on our drama project. We will be learning about adjectives and verbs and will use these to write a poem. We will be extending our sentences using exciting adjectives and connectives. We will be working on using full stops and capital letters confidently in our writing, as well as beginning to join our handwriting. We will be completing a piece of 'Big Writing' each week.
