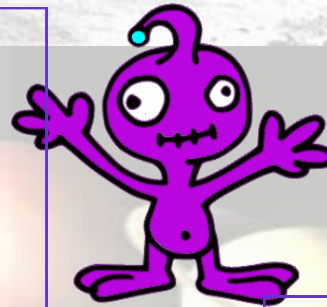
What do astronauts do to stay fit in Space?
