

Science

We will be learning all about life cycles of humans, mammals, frogs and butterflies.

This will include learning about offspring.

DT

We will be making our own beautiful fireworks using a range of resources.

English

We will be reading some lovely stories set on a farm, which we will explore through discussion and drama. We will use paired and individual writing to write our own farm stories. We will learn how to use “?” and “!” to make our writing lively.

We will be exploring an art programme called Dazzle to create our own firework pictures. We will also be using the internet to research the Gunpowder Plot.

Maths

We will be using addition and subtraction methods to solve word problems. We will also be looking at shape and symmetry. We will continue to learn about money and use this in role play. We will begin to look at different types of graphs and ways to record our investigations. Finally, we will begin to learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Music

We will be learning new songs as well as playing instruments and learning their names.

History
