Nursery Admissions Information for Entry in 2016/17

Oswald Road Primary School has a 54 place Nursery. This is made up of 52 full time places and 4 part time places. The information below should provide answers to the most common queries. More detailed information is contained in our full policy and procedure which can be found on our school website at www.oswaldroad.co.uk/parents/admissions.

Q. When is my child old enough to join the School Nursery?

A. Children must be aged three or four years old in order to join the nursery.

Q. When can I apply for a nursery place for my child?

A. Applications open from September to April in the year proceeding your child's entry to the Nursery. We do not take applications earlier than this nor do we carry applications over to subsequent years.

Q. Can I look around the school and nursery before applying?

A. Yes, please contact us for school tour dates on the details below.

Q. How do I apply?

A. You can collect an application form from the school. Alternatively, one can be downloaded from the school website, www.oswaldroad.co.uk/parents/admissions. When returning your application form you need to include the following documents:

- Proof of your child's identity i.e. birth certificate or passport, and
- Proof of your child's permanent home address e.g. a recent utility bill, bank statement or Council Tax letter etc.

Q. How do you decide who gets a nursery place?

A. If we are oversubscribed we use the following criteria to determine who gets a place:

1. Children in Local Authority care
2. Children with exceptional medical/social needs
3. Siblings of children who already attend Oswald Road Primary School and who are living at the same address and children of staff who have worked at the school for more than two years.
4. Distance from the school as measured in a straight line.

Q. When will I hear if my child has a place?

A. We will begin to let you know from March.

Q. Is there a charge for a nursery place?

A. The first 15 hours are free to everyone. Thereafter there is a charge, which at the time of writing is £50 per week. Free places are available which are based on income, social need such as Looked After Children, disability and deprivation indices. More detail is provided in the full policy.

Q. What are the nursery hours?

A. Full time hours are Monday to Friday 9.00am to 3.15pm. Part time places are very limited and are either Monday or Tuesday 9.00am-3.15pm and Wednesday 9.00am-11.30am or Wednesday 12.45pm-3.15pm and Thursday and Friday 9.00am-3.15pm.

Q. Will my child be able to build up gradually to full time hours?

A. Yes, there is a gradual transition within the first week so that your child can get used to the nursery environment. For instance one hour on the first two days, followed by full morning sessions and finally a full day. Transition arrangements will be discussed at the Nursery Transition Meeting before your child begins in September. We will notify you of the date of the meeting.
