- 1. Debs ran through the diary of events for the next week
- 2. Sports Coach to go to Forest Crew with 3SE on Friday afternoon due to parents being in for World Day for Cultural Diversity
- 3. Manchester Day Parade workshop in the studio on Tuesday 23rd May- children making costumes in groups of three.
- 4. Internal Comms Policy will be discussed in the next staff briefing- please can all staff read it before then and go to the office to sign to say that they have done so.
- 5. Time in lieu will be transferred over to Autumn term for the staff presence at school discos during the last week of term.
- 6. - 7. Clarity of leadership roles until July was discussed.
