- 1. Please can staff be more vigilant in picking up on children wearing jewellery in school. Only studs, sleepers (small hoops) and religious jewellery allowed. Any banned jewellery to be confiscated until the end of the day and kept in your desk drawer.
- 2. This week's staff meeting has been changed to focus on radicalisation given recent events in Manchester and London.
- 3. There were a few cases of chicken pox in school before the half term break, so a note has gone out to parents asking them to inform the office as soon as their child shows any symptoms of chicken pox, or any other illness than can be dangerous for pregnant women. Once the office is alerted to a case a whole staff email will be sent out, as well as a message to parents and specific members of staff will be spoken to if necessary. This has been added to the new health and safety policy.
