## Year 3 Stone Age Workshop

As part of our exciting topic, 'The Big Dig', Year 3 will be taking part in a fantastic workshop day led by one of our Stone Age ancestors! During this visit, the Neolithic Stone Age man will arrive, as he did around 12,000 years ago, wearing his fur pelt and carrying his spears and borer as he did alongside his fellow hunter-gatherers around 10000 BC!
