The Hoot

Maths: We are learning about mass this week. The children will be using the balancing scales and objects such as cubes and bricks to weigh different objects. They will also be comparing the weight of two different objects using mathematical language.

Key vocab: Heavy, heavier, heaviest, light, lighter, lightest, equal to.

How you can support at home: Make sure the children are confident with all the vocabulary and can use it to describe the weight of two different objects.

English: We are going to be doing some instruction writing over the next two weeks. We will be learning about 'bossy verbs' that give an instruction and how we can use them in a sentence.

How you can support at home: Encourage the children to give different instructions at home (or you can give them instructions to follow). You can also make sure that they are confident knowing what a verb is (something they do).
