Maths: We will be drawing models to show repeated addition (called arrays) and also making doubles.

Key vocab: array, repeated, group, columns, rows

How you can support at home: Make sure your child is very

confident with the vocabulary (especially columns and rows) and that they are confident counting in 2s, 5s and 10s (forwards and backwards)

English: Our book is 'Too Much Talk', a West African folk tale. The children have been learning the story by acting it out and retelling it and now they are going to think about how to change it ready to write their own version next week. We will be looking at particular aspects of the story including repeated language and different forms of punctuation (including ? and !)

How you can support at home: Ask your child to retell the story to you. Make sure they are familiar with the vocabulary (yams, farmer, weaver, Kente cloth, chief)

Phonics: S, ing, ed. We will be looking at these word endings (suffixes) and practising reading and spelling words with them in.

P5 sounds covered so far: ay, a-e, ou, ie, ea, e-e, ie, i-e, y, ow, oe, o-e, ue, ew, aw, augh, au, ur, ir, ear, or, wh, ph, ou, oi, oy, ear, ere, air, are,

How you can support at home: Continue supporting children with reading and writing words with the above sounds.
