<u>Geography</u> Following on from our study of Cottonopolis, we will look at the effect of the Industrial Revolution on Manchester's landscape.

<u>RE</u> This term we will be comparing the similarities and differences between the major world religions. <u>English</u> This term we will be studying poetry, including Tony Walsh's 'This is the Place' and 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes.

<u>Maths</u> In maths we will be studying volume and converting measure.

<u>PSHE</u> Growing and Changing This units looks at personal identity, friendships and relationships, growing up, body changes and hygiene and personal safety. <u>PE</u> Training for sports day begins! We will dive straight into athletics with sprints, long jump, the javelin throw- you name it! After that, we'll do a summer favourite - tennis.
