

Science – Animals

We will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

History

We will be learning to identify similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods – comparing toys and technology now and in the past

Computing

We will be looking at paint packages on the computer, trying to use a range of paint tools to create images. We will also be using our new class iPads!

Religious Education

Number: Addition and Subtraction

We will be revising our knowledge of addition and relating it to subtraction

Number: Place value to 20

We will continue to look at place value to 20 by comparing numbers and groups of objects, alongside ordering numbers forwards and backwards.

English

We will be continuing to write super sentences with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be reading our work back to make sure it makes sense.

We will be reading a variety of traditional tales and The Jolly Postman.

Art & DT

We will be looking at a range of artists and creating seasonal inspired art work and creating our own puppets.

Physical Education

Gym - we will be linking basic movement together and introducing different equipment
Outdoor games - we will be working on movement with a ball.
