## Year 4 Trip to 'The Beatles Story'

As part of our current topic, which is all about the 1960's, we would like to take the children to Liverpool on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December** to visit 'The Beatles Story' – a museum and exhibition all about the Fab Four and their history. The visit will involve a tour of the museum and a visit to the 'Discovery Zone', where the children will learn all about the Beatles' lives, times, music and legacy using interactive screens and a giant piano!

We anticipate leaving school at 9.05am and returning by 3.30pm. Children will need a warm coat, a drink and a snack, along with a packed lunch. Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give consent via Parent Pay for your child to go on the trip.

School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.

As ever, we will be reliant upon the generosity of our parents/carers in the form of volunteer helpers on the day.
