Year 6 First Aid Training

As part of our 'Extreme Earth' topic, Year 6 looked at the different types of extreme weather and natural disasters that occur around the world and the risks and devastation that these events can cause.

To equip the children for future life, should they be caught in a life-threatening situation, we have been able to enhance our topic by booking First Aid workshops, which will take place at school on Friday 20th March. The workshops, delivered by Red Cross educators, aim to help 10–19-year-olds learn first aid.

A contribution of **£4.50** to cover the costs of the training would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the workshops may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the cost being funded by school, however you will still need to give consent on Parent Pay.

In the workshop the children will:

- Learn essential first aid skills, including how to help someone who is:
 - a) unresponsive (breathing/not breathing)
 - b) bleeding heavily
 - c) burnt.
- Assess and manage risks to make informed choices when helping others.
- Build the confidence and willingness to help in a first aid emergency.

Each workshop will be 60 minutes long.
