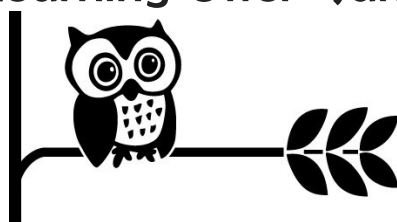


Remote Learning Offer- January 2021



Key Stages 1 and 2:

Remote learning can be accessed on Seesaw and it will include:

- One daily English activity.
- One daily Maths activity.
- At least two other activities.
- All activities will link to the work which would have been covered in class. These activities will include pre-recorded videos, quizzes, and other interactive tools. Where possible, printable resources will be provided. Oak Academy resources might also be used if necessary.
- A daily message from class teachers.
- Recordings of class teachers reading stories to the children.
- A weekly Zoom assembly which will be recorded for those who cannot attend.
- Class teachers will check Seesaw and respond to comments throughout the working day.
- Work will be set by 9am.

Early Years Foundation Stage:

Remote learning can be accessed on Tapestry and it will include:

- Book of the week – an online story.
- One daily Literacy activity.
- Daily phonics session either pre-recorded or set on bug club.
- One daily Numeracy activity.
- One PSED activity for the week.
- One daily Understanding the World or Physical or Creative task.
- Printable resources added to Tapestry linked to the learning for the week.
- A daily pre-recorded story session.
- A video message from the class teacher each day.
- Class teachers will check Tapestry and respond to comments throughout the working day.

Please bear in mind that there can be a few technical issues with remote learning. If you are experiencing difficulties or cannot locate your child's remote learning login details, please contact admin@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk. Your child's class teacher will also be able to support you via Seesaw or Tapestry if you require specific assistance.

All children also have access to Bug Club. Children in Key Stage 1 and 2 can use Spelling Shed, Maths Shed and TTRockstars in addition to this. Oak Academy is also free to access and can be located here: <https://classroom.thenational.academy/>
