## School Streets- Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June

Following the success of Friday's event, we are looking to hold another School Streets on Monday 14th June as part of Clean Air Week (subject to sign-off from the council). On this day, during drop-off and pick-up times (8:15am-9:15am and 2:45pm-3:45pm) the plan is for Nicolas Road to be closed to cars, but remain open for pedestrians, cyclists and scooter riders. The aim of the event is to:

• Raise awareness for children, teachers and parents of the health implications for young people caused by high levels of air pollution and traffic outside our school.

• Involve children, teachers and parents in a fun, symbolic day of action with an opportunity for children to walk to and from school together in a traffic-free space

• Encourage everyone to think about how they travel to school. We hope that closing the road to through traffic will make it easier and safer to walk, cycle or scoot the school run to create a healthier, safer and cleaner environment around the school and local community.
