Health and wellbeing community fair stalls include



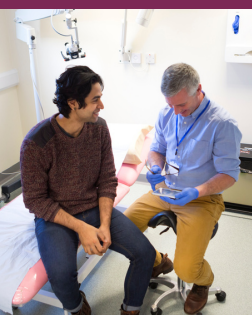
Manchester Adult Education Service: find free courses in maths, English, ESOL and digital skills.
