On Wednesday 23rd March, all Year 5 children will be participating in an Ancient Greek Day run by Portals to the Past. They specialise in providing immersive event days about the history of the period.

The workshop consists of a short introduction to Greek life and culture, followed by four engaging activities:

- A Greek quiz, with loads of fun Greek facts for the children to discover
- Archimedes' Stomachion – the oldest known mathematical puzzle
- Petteia, the Greek strategy game
- Myths and legends – the children are transported to a Greek theatre where they re-enact Greek myths and legends
