Sample Kingswood Packing List

- 1 swimming towel and costume
- 1 bath towel
- Toiletries bag including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush, deodorant (roll-on only, no aerosols)
- Night clothes and slippers
- Socks and underwear (6 sets)
- 4 t-shirts, shirt or blouses (with long sleeves)
- Sweatshirt
- 1 thick jumper
- 1 light sweater
- 3 pairs of trousers and/or jeans and/or tracksuit bottoms clothes for the evening activities
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if possible)
- Sturdy shoes and wellies
- 2 pairs of trainers, including one old pair
- Drinking water bottle
- Sun hat
- Sun cream
- Books, playing cards or small quiet activities
- **Bin bag for dirty clothes**

Please note, many of our activities require arms and legs to be covered.

Children are likely to get muddy or dirty whilst on their activities so **please bring old clothes!** There is a gift shop on site so if children wish to bring pocket money with them we recommend they bring no more than £20.00
