## Year 6 Trip to People's History Museum

The children will leave school at 9:15am and will return at 2pm. We will travel by coach.

If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, appropriate clothing to assist in immediate identification of any pupil attending a trip will be provided.

A contribution of **£4.50** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. This contribution can be made via Parent Pay. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.

Please provide your child with a packed lunch for the trip. All children who are eligible for free school meals can be provided with a school packed lunch if they would like one, alternatively they may bring their own lunch from home. Please make sure your child's lunch is in a rucksack or other bag, which they can carry around with them for the whole day.
