Year 6 Trip to RHS Bridgewater

As a continuation of our involvement in last year's Botany Bay project, Year 6 will be visiting RHS Bridgewater this half term. The Botany Bay project focuses on the botanical and horticultural heritage of Britain. This trip will take place on **Friday 14th October 2022.**

We will leave school at 9:15am and will return in time for the end of the school day. We will travel by coach. Once at RHS Bridgewater, we will be taking part in several activities, including a 'Planting for the Planet' workshop, which links to both the Year 6 science curriculum and our PSHE curriculum.

School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket to wear so that they can be easily identified. As this is an outdoor trip, we also expect children to wear a waterproof coat and sensible, comfortable footwear.

Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If we don't receive an order, we will choose for them based on their dietary requirements.
