Activity ideas:

Key Stage 1:

- Create and label a family tree.
- Design a powerpoint presentation.
- Design a vocabulary poster.
- Make up a play about your family.
- Design and label an artefact associated with your famous person.
- Write a short story using Spanish family names.
- Create a Mi Familia wordsearch.

Key Stage 2:

- Create and label an extended family tree.
- Write sentences about your family in Spanish.
- Draw portraits of your family members and describe them.
- Film a conversation asking questions about family and answering them.
- Make up a game using family vocabulary.
