Cloudy Lemonade

Ingredients


- •6 8 large lemons
- 150g caster sugar
- 1 litre cold water (still or sparkling)
- plenty of ice cubes

Method

- 1. Add all the sugar and enough water to just cover it to a small saucepan and simmer over a low heat until all the sugar has dissolved. Remove from the heat and allow to cool.
- 2. Juice all the lemons and remove any stones. If you prefer your lemonade with no pulp, pass the juice through a sieve at this stage.
- 3. Add the cooled sugar syrup, lemon juice and cold water to a large pitcher and stir to mix. Serve over ice or store in the fridge for later
