Please note that the coach will return 5 minutes later than 4EC's gate pick up time of 3.15pm on a Wednesday, so these children will arrive slightly later to the Year 4 gate on Wednesdays only.

Please also note that the coach will return at the same time as 4AW's gate pick up time of 3.20pm on a Friday, so again these children may arrive slightly later to the Year 4 gate on Fridays only.

You will collect your children from the Year 4 gate as usual, following the timing guidance above.
