Here's what's happening so far:

LEAVERS' HOODIES

As is tradition for Y6 leavers, we are producing hoodies printed with the name of each child in the year group as a memento, available in a range of sizes and a choice of 5 colours. They can be ordered through this Google Form and paid for via Parent Pay (£18 each, or £9 for Pupil Premium children). The Google Form is also where you will be able to give permission for your child's name to be printed on hoodie.

The hoodies will be delivered to school by mid-June and handed out by the class teacher.

THE PARTY

- 1. <u>Tuesday 20th July 5pm 8pm</u>. This is the last day of term so we thought it would be great for the kids to be able to run off the excitement of the day! We've booked <u>The Carlton Club</u> which has a great outdoor space as well as indoor and have provisionally booked an ice cream van (an ice-cream is included in the ticket price, but drinks can also be purchased at the bar). The club will also open their bar area for the accompanying grown-ups to socialise and celebrate as well. We haven't gone any further with plans as we don't know how much budget we will have, and normal fund-raising routes are still limited. We've lightly spoken about having a disco, photo booth, take away pizzas and obviously copious amounts of sweets! Hopefully this will be able to go ahead in line with the COVID easing roadmap but, like many things at the moment, is subject to last minute changes.

Please buy your child's ticket early via Parent Pay- this will both ensure their place but also provide us with an early indication of numbers and the budget available so that we can get things organised. There will be the option to make an additional donation for anyone who can afford it if you can it would greatly contribute to the overall quality of the event. Once we know what funds are available, we can start to make more concrete plans. We'd like all children to be able to attend so want to make it as inclusive as possible.

For safeguarding reasons we'll be recording attendance and the name of the adult that is staying for the event thanks in advance for your support on this.
