If you feel you need some extra support, the Early Help service can help to get things working again for you and your family. We believe effective Early Help is essential to improve the life chances of Manchester's children, young people and their families.

An Early Help assessment looks at five key areas of your family's life: Home, Education, Work, Health and Community. The assessment identifies what is working well and what could work better. Your school based Early Help practitioner can then provide additional information, advice and guidance, or maybe some specialist help to support your family. There are a wide range of services that work in partnership with Early Help to offer support to the families of Manchester.
