On December 1st 1955, Rosa Parks refused to give up her bus seat for a white passenger, sparking a wave of change against segregation. Listen to how one woman changed the lives of millions.

- The famous bus story and how she bravely stood up for what she believed in
- The impact of her actions and how one person can change the world
