Year 6 Trip - Imperial War Museum North

Year 6 will be visiting the Imperial War Museum North this half term as part of our History topic about the causes and consequences of World War I.

This trip will take place on two separate dates:

Friday 3rd February 2023 – Miss Beech and Mrs Gibson's Class

Friday 17th February 2023 – Miss Cawley's Class

The children will leave school at 9:15am and will return in time for the end of the school day. We will travel by tram. Once at the Imperial War Museum we will be taking part in several activities, including a *Ministry of Memory* workshop, which links to both our History and PSHE curriculums.
