Dear Parents/Carers,

Y3 Trip to Chester

On Thursday 11th May, Year 3 will be visiting Chester as part of our learning around the impact of the Roman Empire in Britain.

During the trip we will be viewing a number of Roman sites and artefacts as well as having a real-life encounter with a Roman soldier, complete in uniform and with weapons! In past years the children have loved this visit and many children in Year 5 and 6 speak fondly of their memories of it.

The museum has a shop where children can buy a memento of their visit. We suggest a maximum of £2.00 per child but this is entirely optional. Your child can look after the money themselves, or it can be handed to the class teachers in a named, sealed envelope and we can distribute when we are there.

Lunch:

Children should bring a packed lunch. If your child is usually on school dinners, the kitchen will provide one for them.

Clothing:

Please send your child in to school in appropriate, comfortable clothing for the day. Please also ensure your child is wearing a red school jumper on the day of the trip. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.

Timings:

The visit will last all day. We will leave school at approximately **9am** and aim to return to school by **4pm**. We are sorry that this is after our usual finish time but we will not finish at the museum until around 2:30pm and we may hit traffic on the way back.
