Libya Appeal

Storm Daniel caused tsunami-like floods in Libya on 10th September. Many people lost everything. Homes, buildings and entire neighbourhoods were swept away by the floods. Thousands are mourning loved ones. Libyan Red Crescent was first on the ground evacuating people, providing first aid and carrying out search and rescue.

Morocco Appeal

The Moroccan earthquake disaster has claimed over 3,000 lives and left thousands injured. While aid has reached more isolated regions, there is an urgent need to scale up shelter and sanitation efforts. Many people have been left with nothing. The earthquake has left thousands of families exposed to harsh conditions. As Winter approaches, the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) has highlighted an urgent need for warm shelter as many people have lost their homes.
