## Year 1 Delve Into History – Neil Armstrong Workshop

As part of our exciting topic next half term about the moon landing, we have arranged for Delve into History to visit our school to deliver an exciting workshop: Neil Armstrong – from childhood dreams to walking on the moon.

During this workshop pupils will listen to the story of how Neil Armstrong became an astronaut. Pupils will learn about his early life before he became famous. They will be immersed in role-play, meeting Neil as a young boy, a boy scout, a jazz musician, a naval pilot and finally an astronaut.

During the story pupils will listen to the of music Neil Armstrong's college band, take part in astronaut training exercises and through costume see him grow from a young boy to a man. Pupils will have the opportunity to look at artefacts relating to the 1969 moon landing.
