Year 2 Trip to Staircase House

As part of our upcoming topic 'The Great Fire of London', planned for Spring 2, we will be visiting Staircase House in Stockport. It's a fantastic way to bring the topic to life and when we've been in the past the children have really enjoyed it. On the day, as well as exploring the House and reenacting 'A Week in the Life of Samuel Pepys', the children will be taking part in two workshops called 'Wattle and Daub' and 'Fire Marks'.

The dates for the trip are as follows:

Friday 8th March – Class 2A
Friday 15th March – Class 2C
Monday 25th March – Class 2B

We will be leaving school at 9am and travelling by coach to Staircase House, returning to school in time for the end of the day. A contribution of £22 to help cover the costs will be appreciated. A Parent Pay item will appear on your account. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may have to be cancelled. If your child is entitled to free school meals, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.

All children on school dinners will be provided with a free school packed lunch, however you may provide your own if you wish. If your child is usually on packed lunch, please bring this in as usual.

Please ensure your child is also wearing a red school jumper on the day of the trip. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.
