Year 2 Trip to Southport – Thursday 23rd May

Dear Parents/Carers,

To enrich our Geography topic on Coasts we have arranged a trip to Southport. We will be taking part in lots of fun activities and finding out more about human and physical Coastal features. During the day the children will be involved in teacher led exploration and investigative activities around the Coasts. We have also arranged a visit to Southport Lifeboat Station to learn more about the important work the volunteers do here. Your child will need to have appropriate clothing for the day.

We will be leaving school at 9am and travelling by coach to Southport, returning to school in time for the end of the day. A contribution of **£14** to help cover the costs will be appreciated. A Parent Pay item will appear on your account. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may have to be cancelled. If your child is entitled to free school meals, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.

All children on school dinners will be provided with a free school packed lunch, however you may provide your own if you wish. If your child is usually on packed lunch, please bring this in as usual.

Please ensure your child is wearing a red school jumper on the day of the trip. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will be given one from the spares box, as well as a high-vis jacket so they can be easily identified.
