Year 1 Lyme Park Trip

As part of Year One's Geography topic 'Is everywhere in the UK like Chorlton?' we will be taking the children on a trip to The National Trust's Lyme Park. During this visit we will be looking at the similarities and differences between the geographical features of Lyme Park and our local area, Chorlton. The trip will also link to our Science topic "Plants" and the children will be able to enjoy the Crow Wood Playscape. The visit will take place on **Monday 22nd July.**

All Year 1 classes will be **leaving at 9.00am** and **returning at 2.45pm.**

Please ensure your child wears trainers or walking shoes and a suitable coat. Sun protection such as sun cream and a sun hat should also be worn.

As we will not return to school in time for lunch, we are requesting that children bring a packed lunch on that day. All children who have a school meal will be provided with a school packed lunch, alternatively they may bring their own packed lunch from home.

School jumpers and/or t shirts are to be worn for the trip. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, they will be given a high vis jacket to wear so that they can be easily identified.

A contribution of **£13.00** per child to help cover the cost of the visit would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip will have to be cancelled. Please consent and make payments via ParentPay. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.
